Cultural Treasures of Japan

October 6-19, 2019

HIGHLIGHTS: Tokyo, Kyoto, Bullet Train, Hiroshima, Lake Ashi Cruise, Matsumoto Castle, Geisha Show

Our tour begins in the amazing city of Tokyo where we will visit the Imperial Palace, Niju Bridge and Sakurada Gardens. Our climb during the famous Tokyo tour will give us an amazing view of the city from high above. Throughout this tour we will explore ancient and modern Japanese culture firsthand. Now on to the lakeside resort of Kakone, renowned for its hot springs. Take a ride on the Hakone Ropeway, an aerial cable car, for a breathtaking view of Mt. Fuji. Next we cruise the deep blue waters of Lake Ashi, with epic mountain views. Step back in time in the rural Edo-period town of Takayama, nestled in the Japanese Alps, where we will tour Matsumoto Castle. We will visit a 200-year-old sake brewery and later, a 600-year-old open air market along the Miyagawa River.

On our travels today to Kanazawa, we visit Shirakawa-go, with its gassho-zukuri-style houses with their thatched-rooftops. Our next stay is in Kyoto where we find more than 2000 temples and shrines. We will view Kinkakuji, the Golden Pavilion, a Zen temple with two floors that are completely covered in gold leaf. We will also visit the Gion district, with its narrow lanes of teahouses. We board the Shinkansen bullet train for Hiroshima. On this adventure we take a ferry to Miyajima Island to see the iconic Torii gate and the Itsukushima Shrine that appears to float on water. Now we are on the bullet train back to Kyoto. Today we tour Nijo Castle and later we get a lesson in the art of Japanese stenciling. We end our tour with a special kaiseki farewell dinner and Geisha show.

The cost of this amazing 14 day tour is **\$6399** which includes hotel, air, air taxes, included tours, transfers and our roundtrip flight out of SFO. ICELAND's Magic Northern Lights

February, 12 - 19, 2020

HIGHLIGHTS: *Reykjavik, Northern Lights Cruise, Golden Circle, Blue Lagoon
Vatnajokull Glacier, Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon, Gullfoss Waterfall, Vik*

Iceland, the land of steaming lava fields, massive glaciers and thundering waterfalls. We start in Reykjavik, Iceland's capital city. We visit old town, the harbor and then after dinner, off to a Northern Lights cruise to see one of nature's wonders, the aurora borealis. Next day we travel the incredible Golden Circle in route to Vik. On our way we visit Thingvellir National Park, a Unesco World Heritage site. Then we stop at the geothermal fields of Geysir and Strokkur. We will also see the beauty of Gullfoss waterfall. The next day we take a drive to the mesmerizing Seljalandsfoss, to see the Skogafoss waterfalls, one of the largest in Iceland. Then on to see Reynisfjara, a black volcanic sand beach surrounded by basalt formations. See the unique natural rock formations at Dyrholaey. Today we travel to Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon, filled with floating icebergs. Travel to Skaftafell, gateway to Vatnajokull National Park, the largest national park in Europe. Vatnajokull is known for having Iceland's highest mountains and the Vatnajokull glacier, Europe's largest. Tonight we will again search for the Northern lights. Today we drive along the south shore towards Reykjanes Peninsula, stopping at the Lava Exhibition Center to learn about Iceland's historic eruptions and current lava flow. We then visit the Blue Lagoon hot springs. Take a dip in the warm rich mineral waters of the geothermal pool located in the middle of a dramatic lava field. We then return to Reykjavik for our farewell dinner and another chance to see the Northern Lights. Our last day in Reykjavik is for resting, shopping and seeing the old town. Tomorrow we head for home and leave this amazing, beautiful landscape.
